

Adding ABUS To Mammography May Increase Detection Rate Of Invasive Breast Cancers.

[Aunt Minnie](#) (11/21, Yee) reports that according to a study published Oct. 17 in the journal Radiology, “adding automated breast ultrasound (ABUS) to mammography for breast cancer screening increases the detection rate of invasive cancers by more than 30%.” The study, which “included more than 15,000 women who presented for screening mammography with heterogeneously or extremely dense breasts but no other known risk factors,” also found that “adding ABUS to mammography increased the sensitivity rate by 26.7%.”
