
Pennsylvania Bill Seeks To Require Notification Of Breast Density After Mammogram.

Bob Mensch, R-Montgomery County, is leading the fight for a bill requiring radiologists to provide...information” on breast density “to all women following a mammogram.” Lawmakers “made minor amendments to the legislation last week, which were approved without opposition in the House Health Committee.” Approximately “half of all women have dense or extremely dense breasts, according to the American College of Radiology.”
