

Seeing Fetal Ultrasound Images May Help Dads Bond With Their Babies.

[HealthDay](#) (5/1, Preidt) reports that according to a study published online April 21 in the journal *Fatherhood*, “seeing the first ultrasound images of their unborn babies helps fathers bond with their children.” After interviewing “22 expectant fathers, aged 23 to 41, in Michigan after they viewed a routine ultrasound of their unborn child taken at weeks 16 to 20 of pregnancy,” researchers found that “the ultrasound helped the men truly understand that they were going to have a child and reassured them that all was well with the pregnancy.”
