

Tomosynthesis-Mammography Combo May Reduce Screening Recall Rates.

[Health Imaging](#) (11/25, Steere) reports that, according to a study published in the December issue of the journal *Radiology*, “patients undergoing conventional mammography paired with tomosynthesis had significantly lower screening recall rates than those receiving mammography alone.” In the study, “13,158 patients underwent screening mammography, 6,100 underwent tomosynthesis plus mammography, and 7,058 underwent digital mammography alone.” Researchers found that the “impact on recall rates was particularly strong for those younger than 50 and those with dense breasts.”
